The Family Self-Sufficiency Program provides families with public and personal resources that lead to economic independence. The FSS program is designed to assist families in becoming self-sufficient by promoting employment, increasing assets, and reducing dependence on government subsidies and public assistance. The services received from the program are based on specific goals as well as a plan of action. The goals decided upon are up to you. A five year contract must be signed in order to participate in the FSS program. A major benefit of joining the FSS program is the growth in a savings plan. Over the course of five years, based on your increasing earned income, you may build an escrow account that becomes available to you upon completion of your goals and graduation date.
